

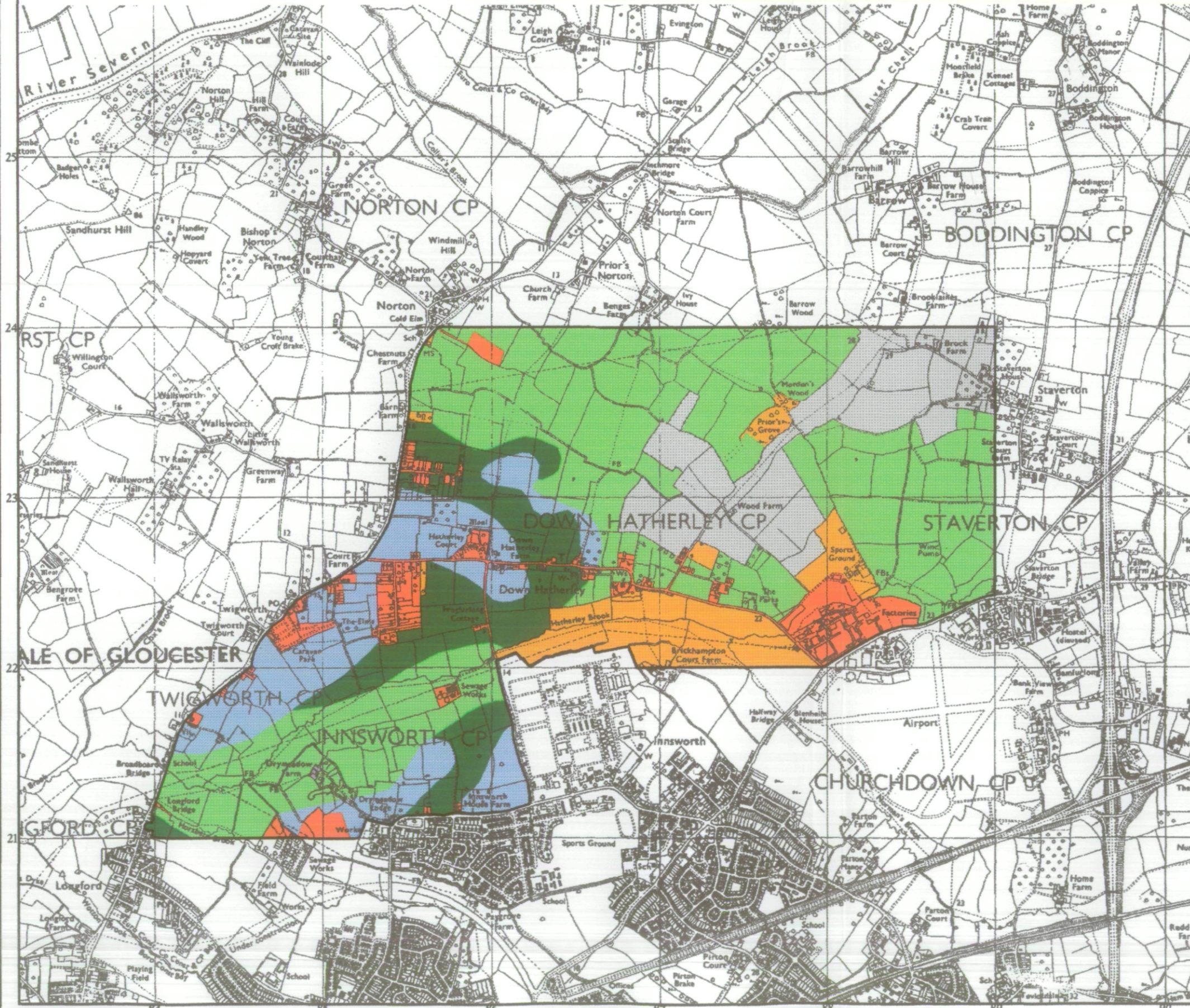

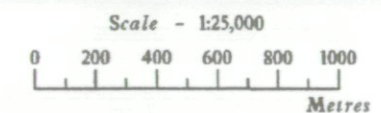

1* LOCATION OF AUGER SAMPLE POINT



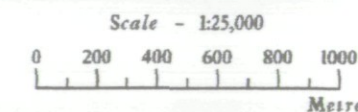
