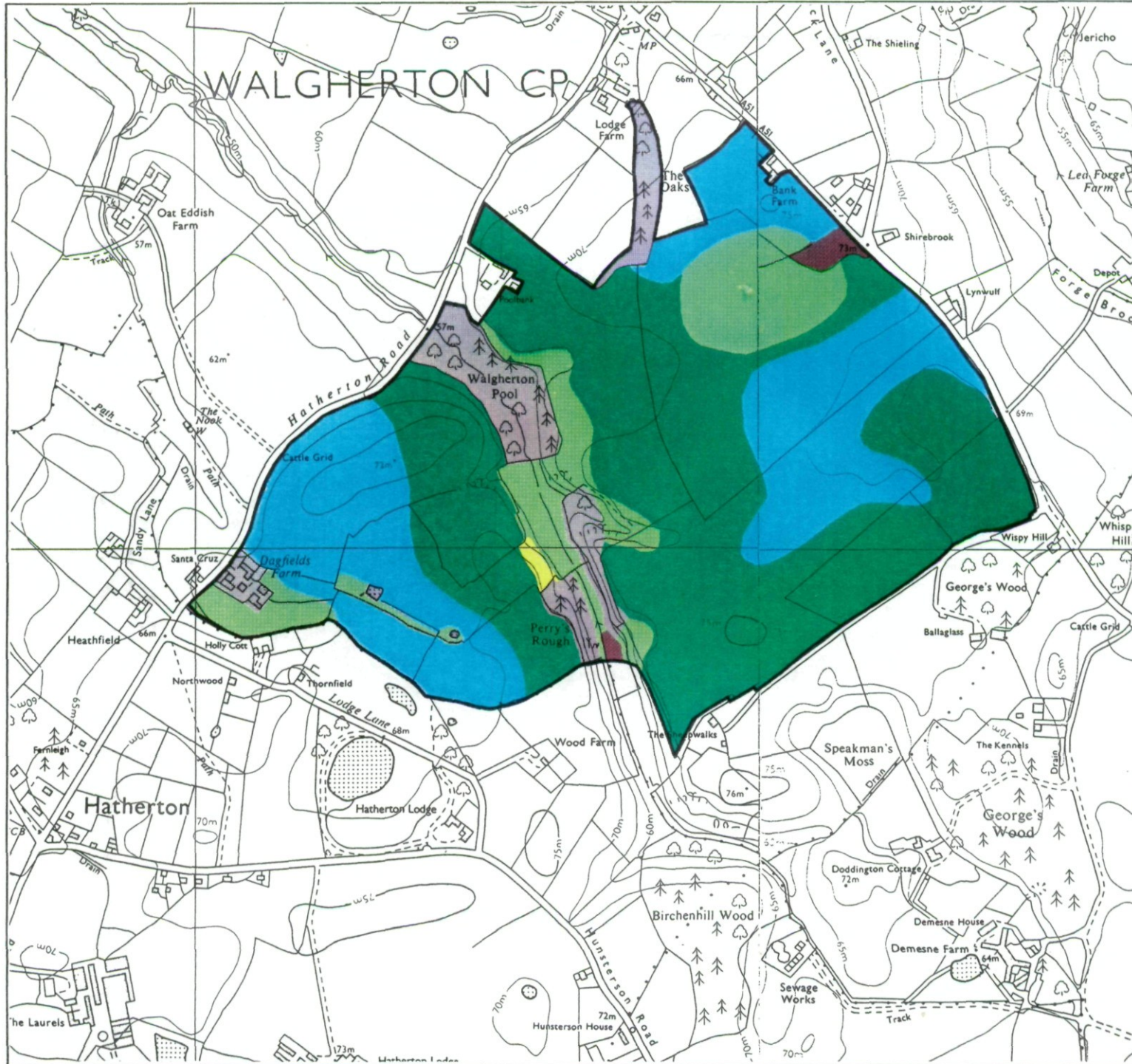

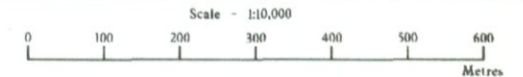

Site 25: (Construction sand)



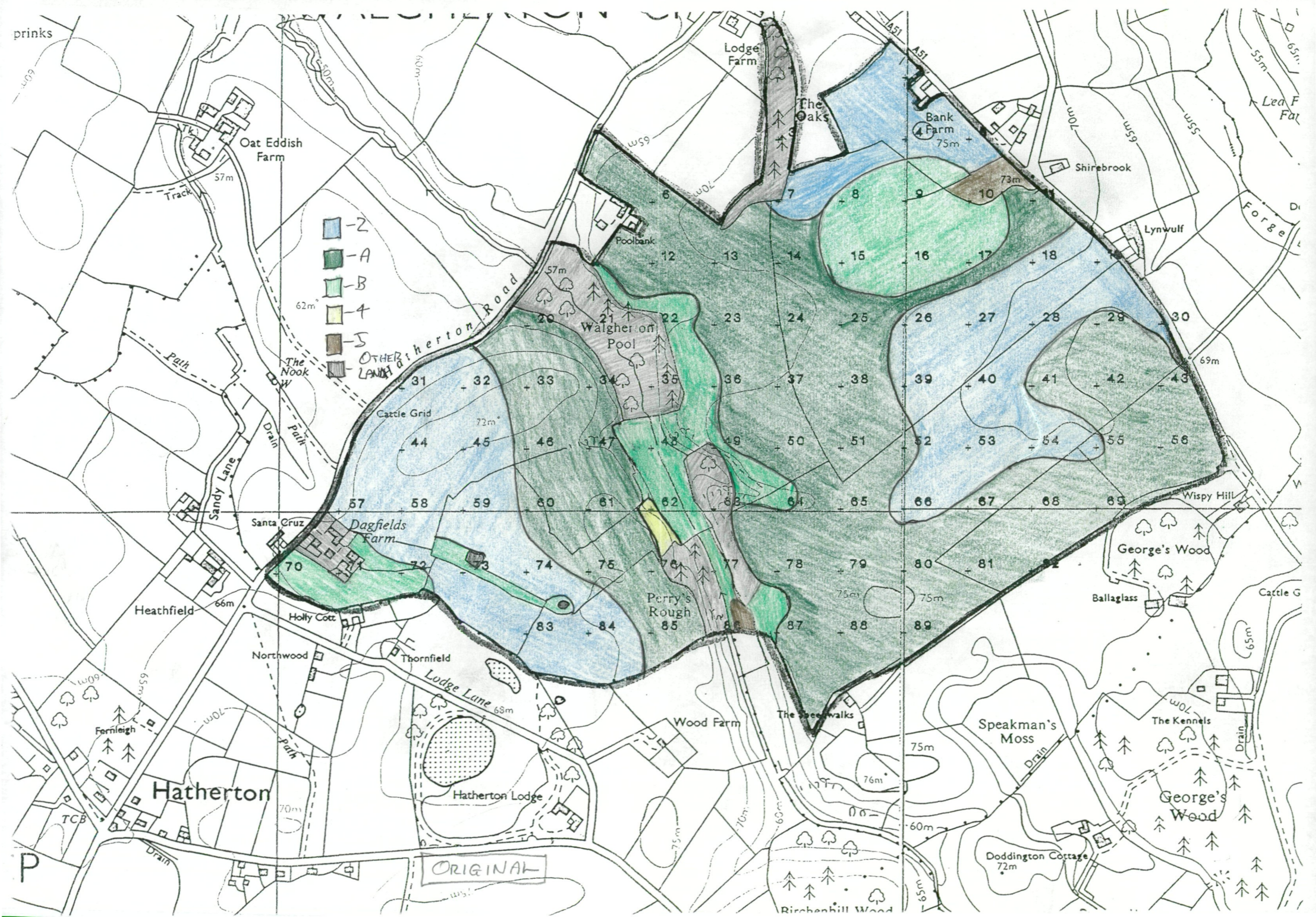
