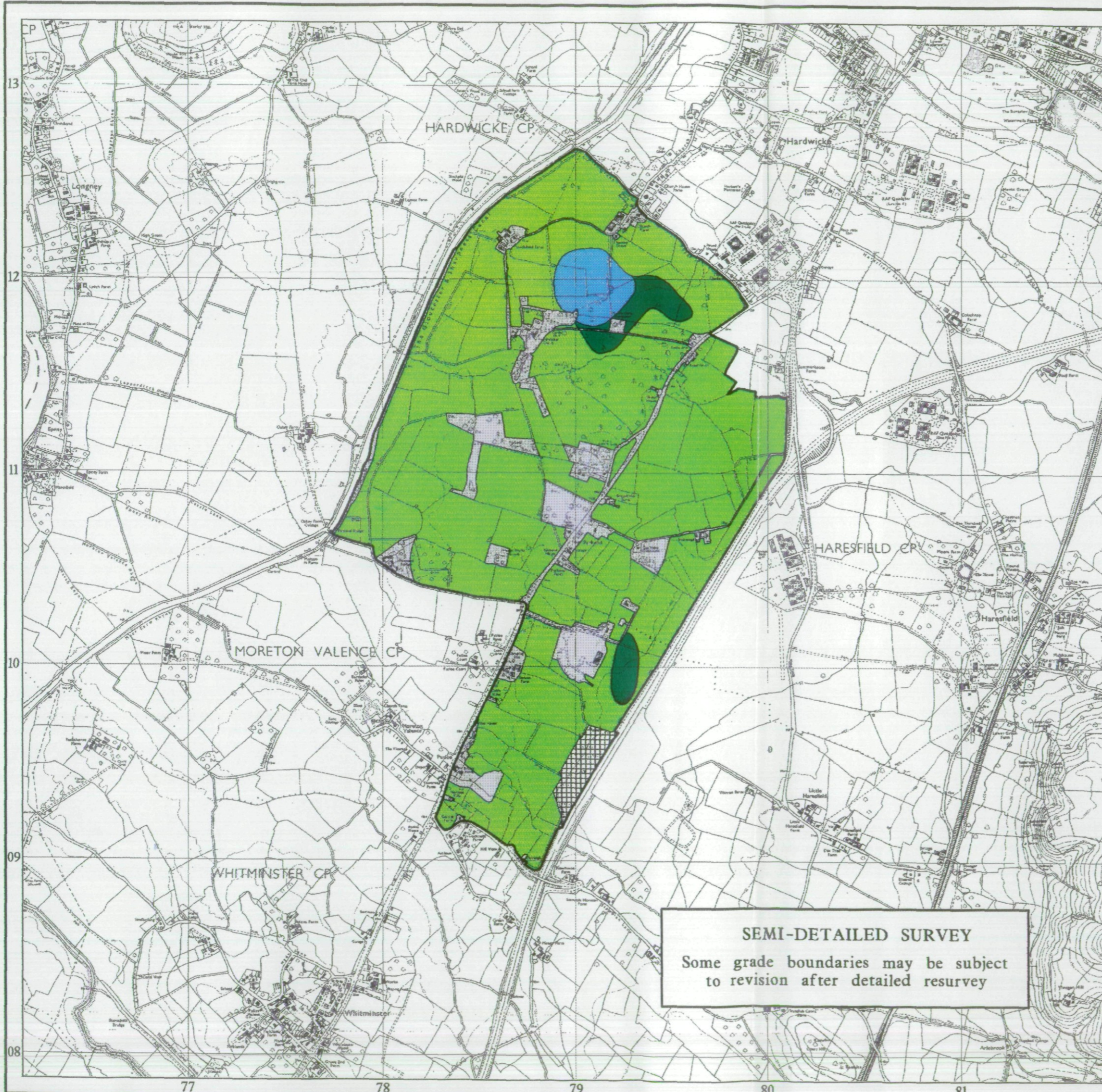

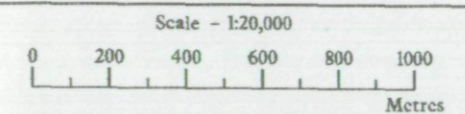



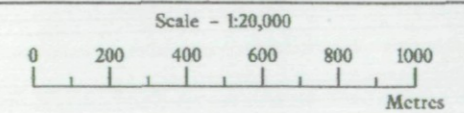

-  Other land

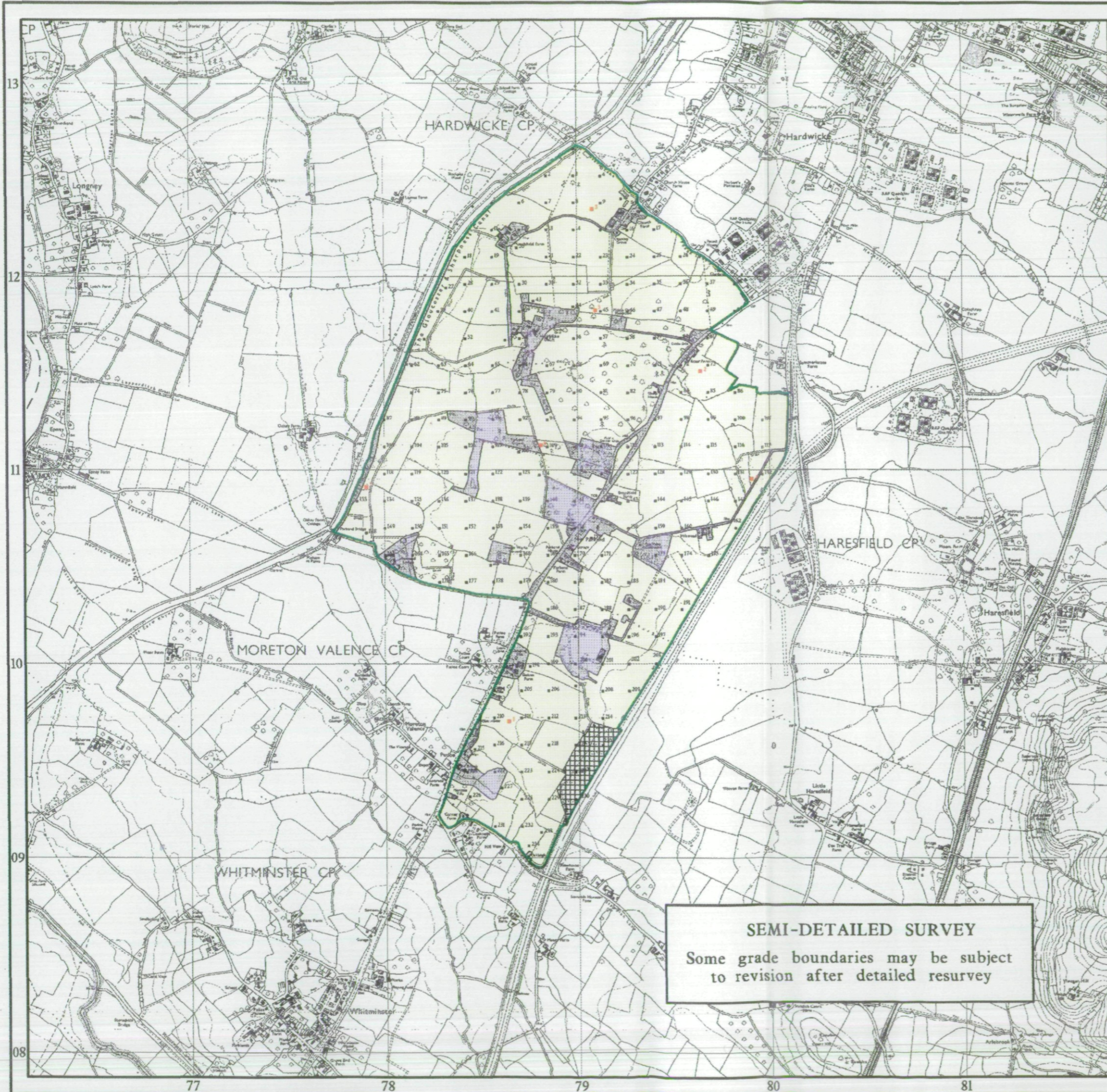
