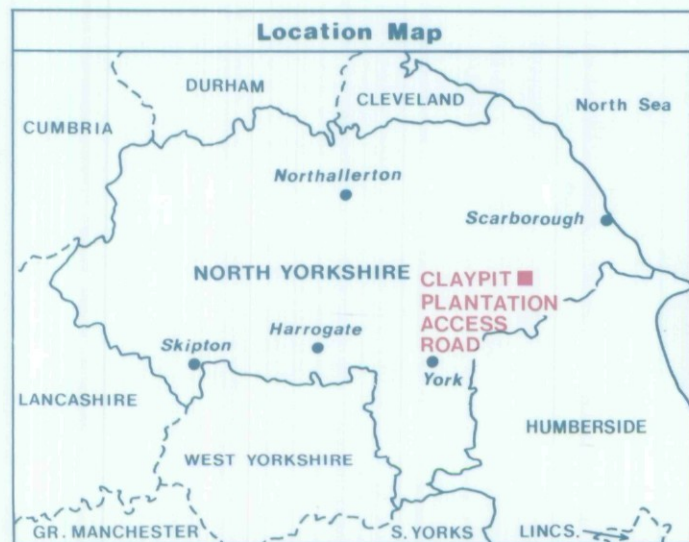
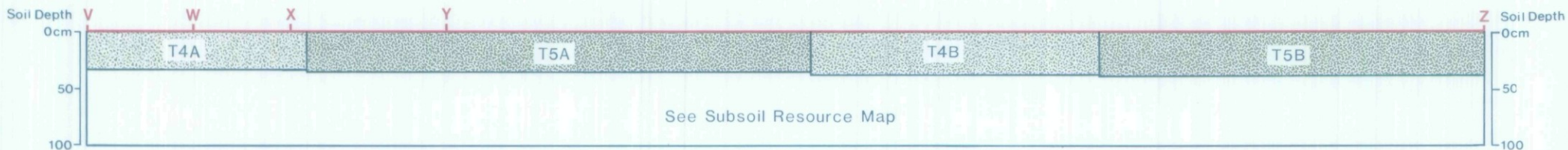


CLAYPIT PLANTATION ACCESS ROAD



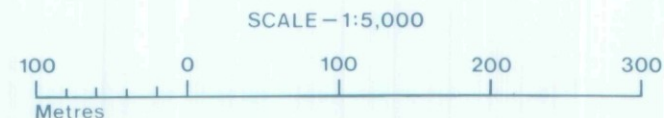

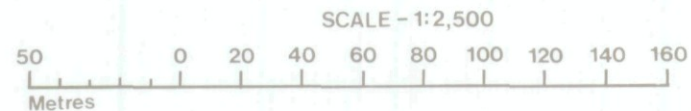

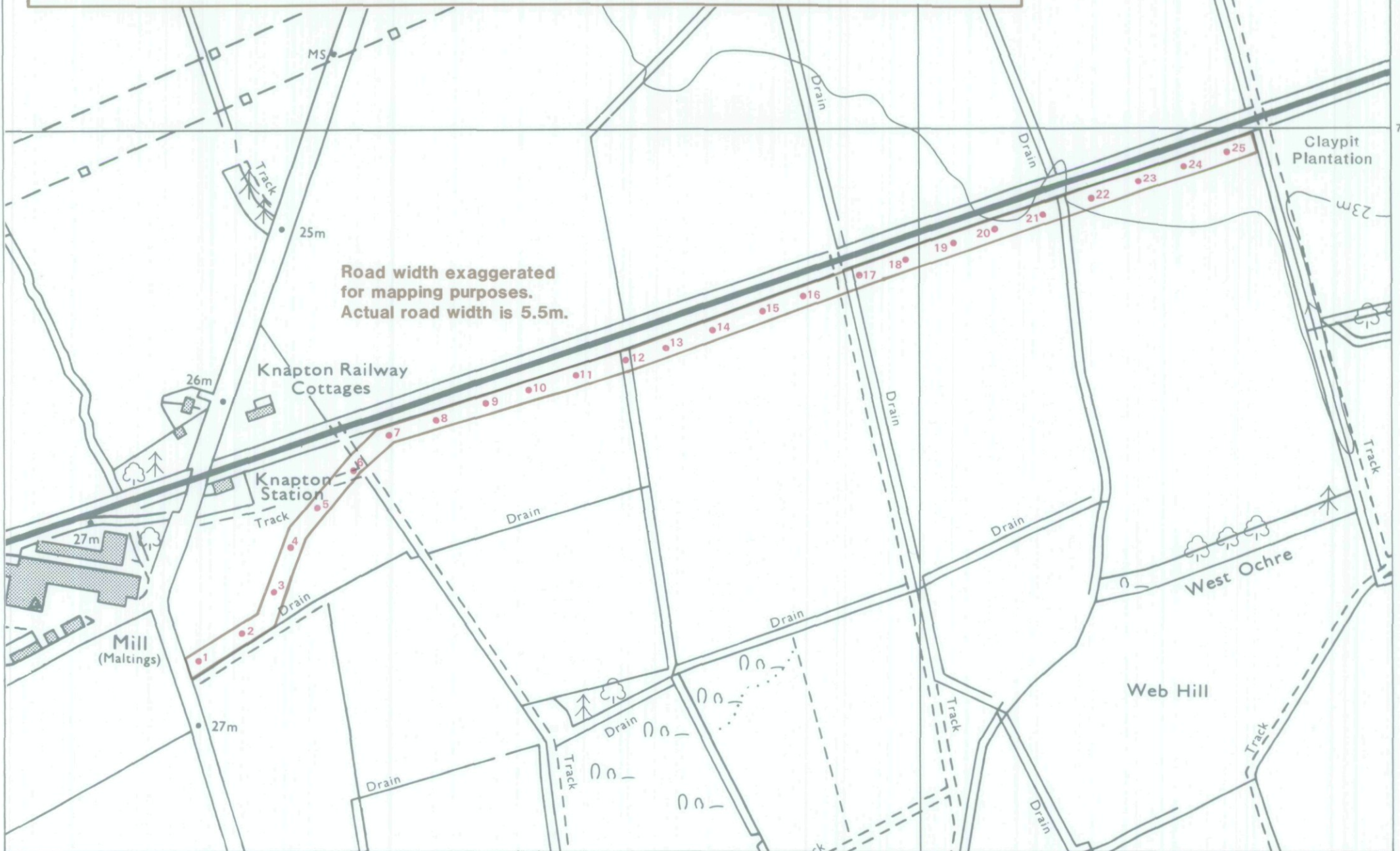

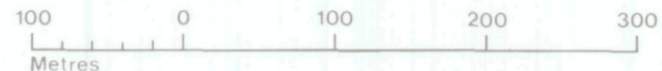
