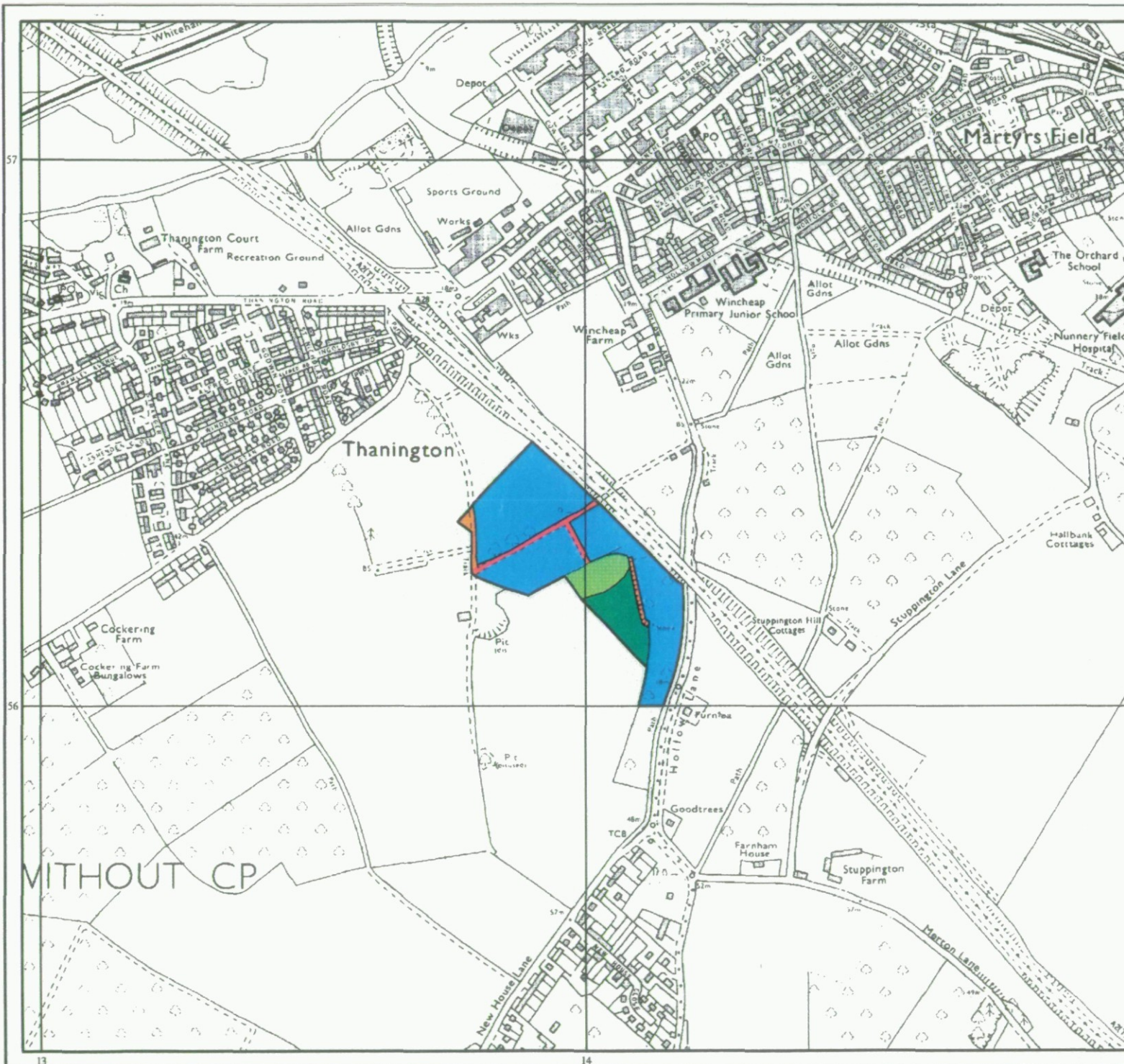



-  LOCATION OF AUGER SAMPLE POINT

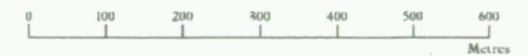

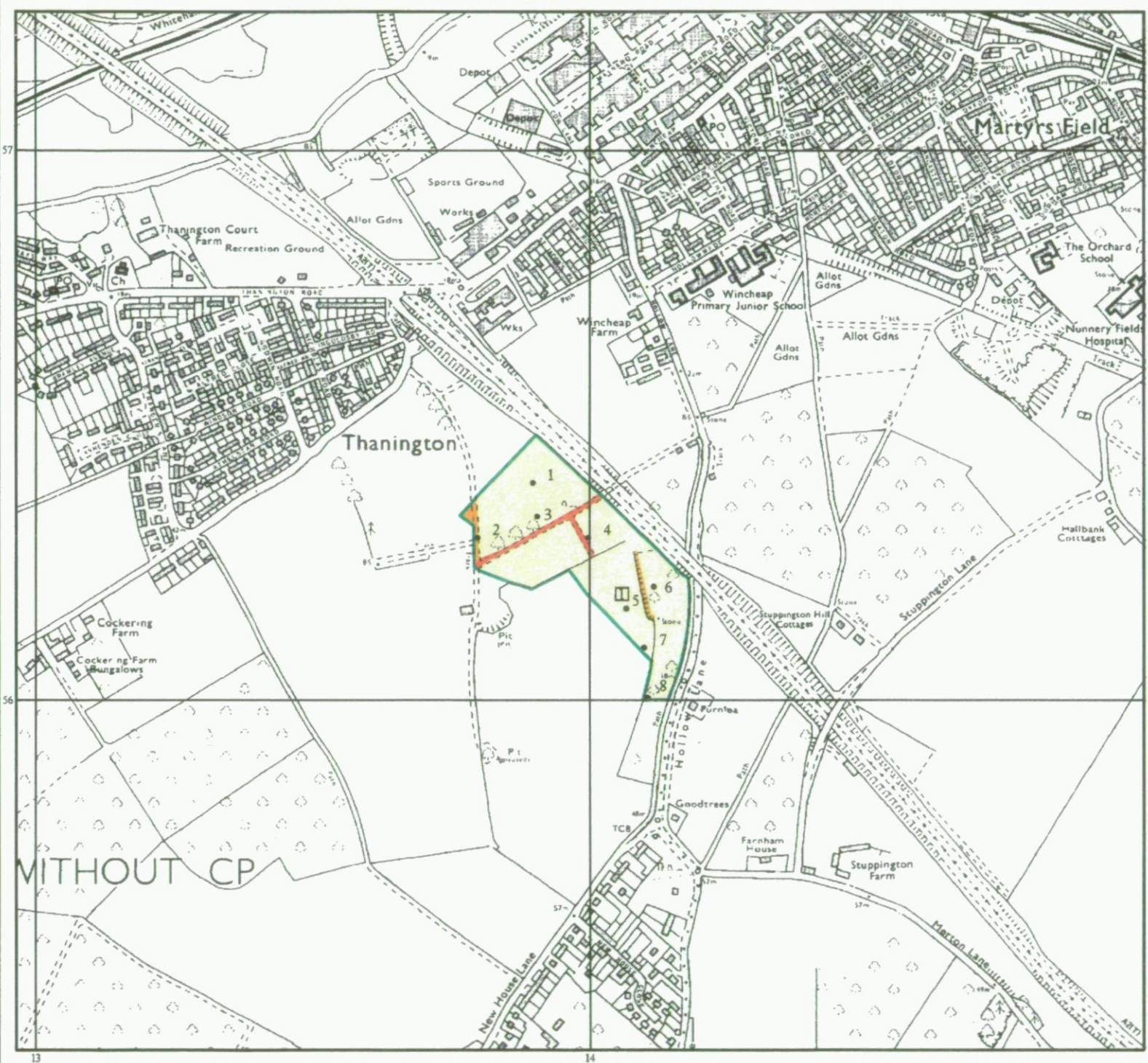
